Sub: IFHRMS – RE / FMA / FSE for the year 2019-20 –  
Existing ATBPS mode for Non-Go-live locations –  
Authenticated copy of RE for Go-live locations - Reg.

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The process of Revised Estimate (RE) allocation for the year 2019-2020 is yet to be completed through the IFHRMS system. A few departments have raised the issue of allocating the Revised Estimate (RE) 2019-20 funds to the Drawing and Disbursing Officers (DDOs) through the IFHRMS system and requested suitable clarification from the Government.

2. The matter has been examined by the Government in consultation with Commissioner, Treasuries and Accounts Department and accordingly the following clarifications are issued:

a) Revised Estimate (RE) / Final Modified Appropriation (FMA) / Final Supplementary Estimates (FSE) Fund Allocation: The Heads of Departments should continue to issue the conventional offline allocation proceedings for allocation of the funds provided in RE / FMA / FSE 2019-2020 to the DDOs.

b) In respect of IFHRMS Go-Live Districts (Karur, Theni, Salem, Kanniyakumari, Madurai (PAO), Ariyalur and PAO (Secretariat): The DDO concerned should approach the related Sub-Treasury / District Treasury office with the authenticated offline copy of RE / FMA / FSE allocation for uploading in IFHRMS. The District / Sub Treasury Office / Officer, after due verification, should upload the revised fund allocation through the WEB-ADI option provided in IFHRMS. Thus, after ensuring RE / FMA / FSE upload by Treasury, the DDO will be able to present the bills in the IFHRMS for incurring in the expenditure as per norms.



c) In all other non Go-Live Districts / PAOs, the bill processing will continue to be done in the existing ATBPS mode only. Therefore, the DDOs in these locations should continue to present the non-salary bills based on the conventional budget allocation given by the higher level officials as usual.

d) The above guidelines / directions have already been conveyed to the Treasuries / PAOs also.

3. In view of the above, the HODs are requested to give suitable instructions to all the DDOs for proper utilisation of the RE / FMA / FSE for the year 2019-2020. This letter will be hosted in the IFHRMS website also and can be referred by all the DDOs for further action.
